



# POWERFUL PRESENTATIONS WITH GOOGLE SLIDES

Section 3 Exercise




1. Create a blank slide presentation by visiting **slides.google.com** and choosing the option to create a Blank presentation.




2. We need to alter the size of the slide so it's the correct size for a social media card. Click **File** → **Page Setup**.

3. From the drop down menu at the top of the dialog box choose **Custom**.




4. Enter dimensions of **800** by **419** and choose **pixels** from the drop down box. These are the dimensions of a standard Twitter Card. Click Apply.



5. Delete the existing content from the slide.


6. Drag the image provided called **strength.jpg** on to the slide. It has been sized to fit exactly over the slide area.

7. If needed adjust the position of the image and the sizing handles on the image borders so that the image covers the slide.
